**Powell Lake Township Park**

Location: 530 Pontiac St.  
(adjacent to the Library)

Hours: 8:00 am to 9:00 pm year round

This 56-acre park features a passive recreation activity, including a 1-mile A.D.A. approved asphalt nature trail, fishing on Powell Lake, boardwalks and access to the Polly Ann Trail.

**Seymour Lake Township Park**

Location: 2795 Seymour Lake Road  
(West of M-24)

Hours: 8:00 am to 10:00 pm year round

This 125-acre park has four lighted tennis courts, four softball fields (two lighted), four baseball fields, eight premier soccer fields, playgrounds, picnic areas, Smith Silo Pavilion, fitness trail, the "Red Flyer Run" sledding hill, 18 hole Disk Golf course, 2 sand volleyball courts, 14 acre multi purpose complex, and is home to "Kids Kingdom" Oxford Township's community built playground. New additions to Kid's Kingdom playground: swing sets, restrooms, and a picnic pavilion.

**Stony Lake Township Park**

Location: 1397 Lapeer Rd.  
(M-24 north of Oxford, just past Ray Rd.)

Hours: 9:00 am to 9:00 pm Memorial Day to Labor Day

Beach Hours: 9:00 am to 8:00 pm daily

This 13-acre park has a beach, three picnic pavilions (Albertson, Brabb, & Martin), a gazebo, restrooms, boat launch, playground, and picnic areas with tables and grills. Stony Lake is a resident only park. Non-resident pavilion guests of Oxford Township Residents may enter the park for a fee of \$5 per car.

**Oakwood Lake Township Park**

Location: 550 Oakwood Rd.  
(east of Metamora Rd.)

Entrance adjacent to the DNR parking area

Hours: 8:00 am to 9:00 pm year round

This 300 acre park was purchased with the assistance of a Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund Acquisition Grant. The 1.5 million dollar park has many beautiful natural attributes as well as a wide variety of wildlife and plants. A branch of the Flint River runs directly through the entire park. A parking lot, numerous hiking trails and paths to Rossman Lake are available.



**PAVILLION RESERVATIONS**

Reservations for pavilions at all Township Parks for the summer of 2009 will be taken at the Parks & Recreation office during regular business hours starting Monday October 6, 2008. Pavilion reservations are available for Oxford Township residents only, except the Smith Silo at Seymour Lake Park. This pavilion is available to residents and non-residents. Reservations will not be accepted over the phone.

**RESIDENT DISCOUNT**

Any registered participant, who resides in the Village of Oxford, Township of Oxford, or who pays Village or Township taxes to the Village or Township of Oxford, is considered a "RESIDENT". Any person fitting this description will be given a discount as noted in each specific program outline. \*Youth participants within the Oxford School District will be recognized as residents.

**CLASS SIZE POLICY**

The Parks & Recreation Commission reserves the right to cancel or adjust any age group of any class that does not meet the minimum class size requirement. In the event a program is cancelled due to this policy, registered participants will receive a FULL REFUND. The minimum class size requirement varies to each specific program.

**REFUND POLICY**

No refunds will be given after the second activity meeting. A \$5 administrative fee will be deducted from all refunds except those cancelled by the Parks & Recreation Commission, which will be paid in full or can be credited to another program or activity.
