

STONY LAKE PARK PAVILION RESERVATION POLICY

SUMMER SEASON: May 1 through October 1
Pavilion hours are 10:00 a.m. – 8:30 p.m.

Due to the shortage of available parking at Stony Lake Park, the seating capacity for all pavilions will be enforced.

Procedures for reserving park pavilions:

1. Reservations must be made in person at the Parks and Recreation Office during regular office hours. No phone reservations are accepted. Reservations for the summer season will be accepted beginning the first Monday in October of the preceding year.
2. The full reservation fee must accompany each application.
3. **Proof of residency must be furnished upon request.**

Rules governing park pavilion usage:

1. Stony Lake Township Park hours are dawn to dusk. Pavilion rental hours are 10:00 am until 8:30 pm.
2. Stony Lake Township Park pavilions are available to residents and non-residents.
3. Reservations for Stony Lake Township Park will be accepted from May 1 through October 1.
4. Vehicles must be confined to parking areas.
5. Watercraft launching is limited to four (4) on a first-come, first-serve basis at Stony Lake Twp. Park.
6. Application/Permit must be retained at all times by user group and presented to Oxford Township Parks and Recreation attendant upon request.
7. The permit is good only for date shown. (There are no rain dates.)
8. Pavilion reservation canceled more than fourteen (14) days before the reservation will result in a five dollar (\$5.00) administrative fee being deducted from the appropriate refund. No refunds are granted after fourteen days prior to the reservation.
9. **The group is responsible for leaving the shelter area clean and orderly.**
10. NO TENTS, TABLES, GRILLS OR CANOPIES are allowed.
11. NO amusement rides, or concessions without written authorization.
12. NO sound systems, speakers, or DJ's, allowed.
13. NO alcohol is allowed in any Oxford Township Park. (Stony, Seymour, Powell, Oakwood).
14. Dogs and other pets are not permitted in Stony Lake Park, except for animals aiding the handicapped.
15. The Oxford Township Parks and Recreation does not monitor swimming, ice conditions or thickness. Swimming, ice fishing and skating is done at own risk. Sledding is prohibited.
