Oxford Township Parks & Recreation health & safety COVID guidelines. As we phase in day and extended travel procedures will look and feel different to keep all our participants safe. The current travel procedure is as follows:

Day of Trip:

- Upon arrival, all participants will be asked to wait in their cars in the designated parking area until the motorcoach arrives.
- When the motorcoach arrives, participants will be asked to sign in on the travel sign in sheet prior to boarding the motorcoach.
- All Medical and Waiver Forms will be completed and collected prior to the trip departure date.
- Disposable self-stick name tags will be used as participant identification.
- Bottled water and pre-wrapped snacks (if provided) will be bagged individually and distributed at the first stop as eating on the motorcoach is prohibited.

All participants will be required to bring and wear their own face mask where it is required.

Before arriving for the trip, all participants are responsible for reading and answering the self-assessment questionnaire which has been provided to you prior to the trip. If you answer yes to any of the questions, do not attend the trip and contact your healthcare provider or Oakland County Nurse On-Call at 1-800-848-5533.

Everyone must sign a new (one time per calendar year) General Waiver of Liability Agreement and OTPR travel sign in sheet (each time) before participating in any trip.

The trip escort will be responsible for making sure the group adheres to trip and motorcoach guidelines and ensure social distancing as best as possible.

Any participant who is sick or has had a temperature of 100°F or over in the previous 24 hours cannot attend the trip. Participants must be fever free without medication for 72 hours before returning to travel and or programs.

Any participant traveling out of the country will be asked to quarantine for no less than 14 days prior to attending the trip.

Any participant who has had direct contact with a person known to be diagnosed with COVID-19 will be asked to quarantine for no less than 14 days prior to attending the trip.

If participant is diagnosed with COVID_19, they must notify the Oxford Township Parks & Recreation or Travel Coordinator as soon as possible.
