This 132-acre park is home to the Parks & Recreation Administrative Office, Senior Center & Oxford Community Television.

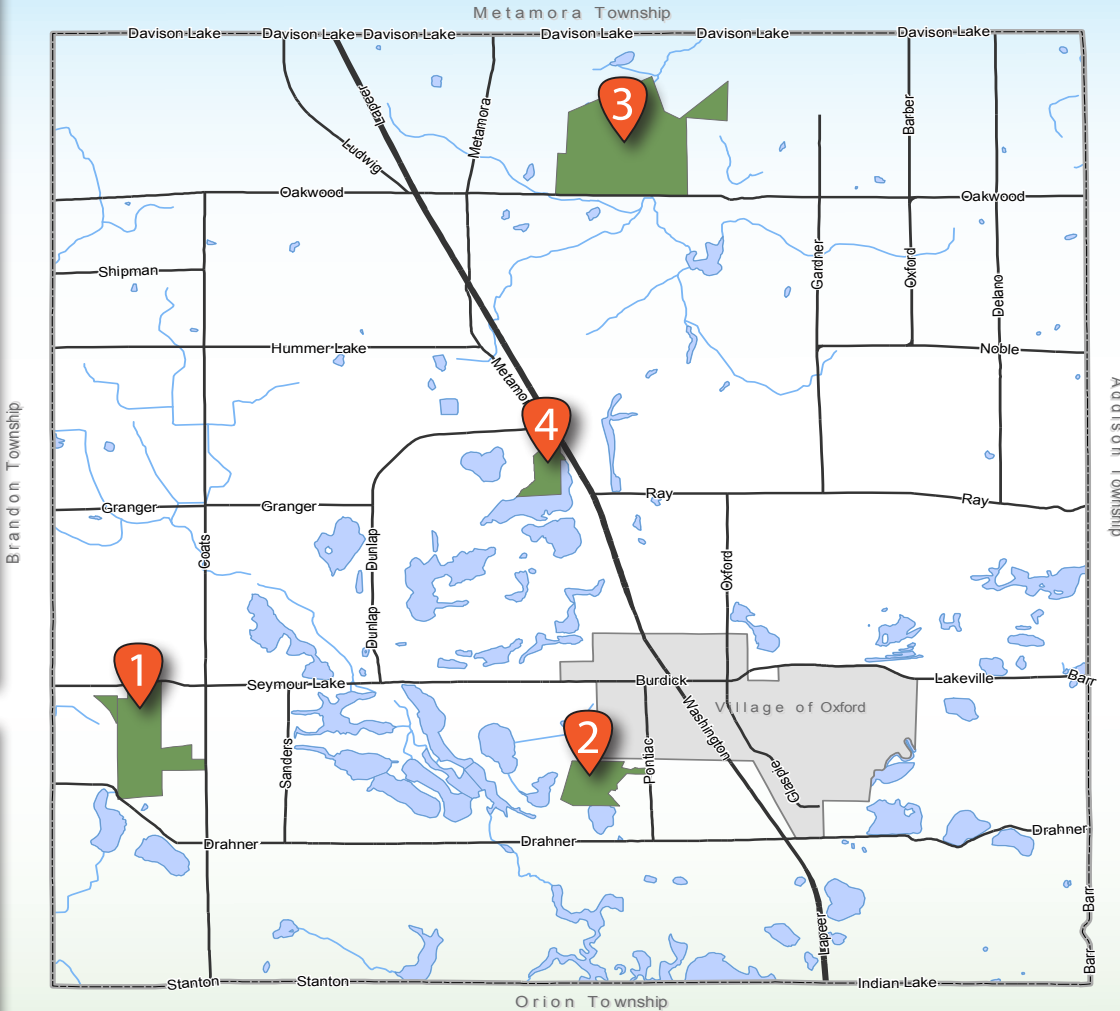


Powell Lake Township Park

This 300-acre park has many beautiful natural attributes as well as a wide variety of wildlife and plants.



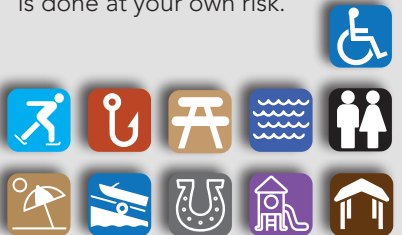
Stony Lake Township Park
