

SEYMOUR LAKE PARK PAVILION RESERVATION POLICY

PAVILION SEASON: May 1 through October 1

Pavilion hours are 9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Due to the shortage of available parking at Seymour Lake Park, the seating capacity for all pavilions will be enforced.

Procedures for reserving park pavilions:

1. Reservations must be made in person at the Parks and Recreation Office during regular office hours. No phone reservations are accepted. Reservations for the pavilion season will be accepted beginning the first Monday in October of the preceding year.
2. The full reservation fee must accompany each application.
3. **Proof of residency must be furnished upon request.**

Rules governing park pavilion usage:

1. Seymour Lake Township Park hours are 8:00 am to 10:00 pm. Pavilion rental hours are 9:00 am until 8:00 pm. There will be supervision in the park everyday.
2. Seymour Lake Township Park pavilions are available to residents and non-residents.
3. Vehicles must be confined to parking areas. (See park attendant for special delivery needs.)
4. Application/Permit must be retained at all times by user group and presented to the park attendant upon request.
5. The permit is good only for date shown. (There are no rain dates.)
6. Pavilion reservation canceled more than fourteen (14) days before the reservation will result in a five dollar (\$5.00) administrative fee being deducted from the appropriate refund. No refunds are granted after fourteen days prior to the reservation.
7. **The group is responsible for leaving the shelter area clean and orderly.**
8. NO TENTS, TABLES, GRILLS OR CANOPIES are allowed.
9. NO amusement rides, or concessions without written authorization.
10. NO sound systems, speakers, or DJ's, allowed.
11. NO alcohol is allowed in any Oxford Township Park. (Stony, Seymour, Powell, Oakwood).
12. Dogs and other pets are not permitted in the athletic areas of the park or where posted, except for animals aiding the handicapped.
13. Pavilion fees do not include the use of any other park amenities requiring fees. (Splashpad, ball fields, soccer fields, sand volleyball, etc.)



The Oxford Parks and Recreation Commission will provide the necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services for individuals with disabilities.
