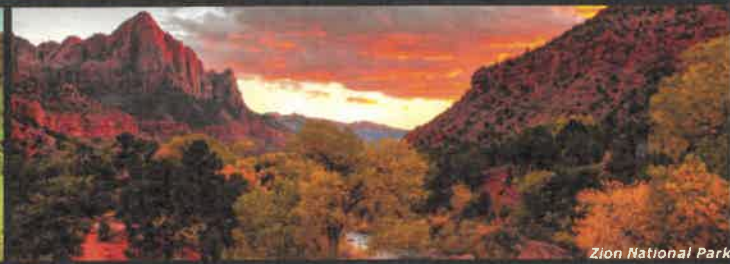

Sample Itinerary:

Day 1: Among the most spectacular trips in America, this tour has it all. **Fly to Denver.** A **city tour** highlights our afternoon. Lodging at **Hampton Inn—Downtown.**
